1 in 8

In their lifetime, **1 in 8 women** will be diagnosed.

382,640

An estimated 382,640 cases of **early-stage breast cancer** are expected to be diagnosed in women in the U.S. in 2026.

168,000

Approximately 168,000 people in the U.S. are living with **metastatic breast cancer**.
